







### **OUR PARTNERS**

Despite global and regional commitments to protect 30% of the Mediterranean Sea by 2030, marine protection remains insufficient and unevenly distributed in the Mediterranean—with only 8% designated, just 0.04% under strict protection, and 90% of MPAs in EU waters—threatening both biodiversity and local livelihoods.

### STRENGTHEN MARINE PROTECTED AREAS

#### **OUR MAIN PROJECT**



#### PROTECTING WHERE IT IS NEEDED

Designate new MPAs in countries with less than 2% of MPA coverage, in the southern and eastern parts of the Med.

#### CREATING STRICTER PROTECTION

Increase the proportion of strictly protected areas, either in MPA core zones or by creating new no-take zones.

With this project, we are expanding and strengthening the MPA network in the region to improve its socio-economic and environmental benefits.

#### **GETTING EVERYONE INVOLVED**

Improve the management effectiveness of existing MPAs and promote participative governance.

#### **ENSURING A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE**

Improve policy frameworks, governance structures, and regional coordination.

#### REWILDING CYPRUS

A project to reduce fishing pressures, implement two no-take zones' and restore seabird and sea turtle habitats in northern Cyprus.





**MED-WIDE** 

#### **MEADOWS4COAST**

A project to promote Posidonia meadows as a nature-based solution against erosion and climate change, including through innovative financing mechanisms.







#### CHANGING NARRA-TIVES FOR 30x30

A project to build public and political support for strict protection. It is implemented in Spain with Med Sea Alliance and aims to expand to the Mediterranean.

**OBJECTIVE 2** 

### REDUCE BYCATCH & FISHING IMPACT ON BIODIVERSITY

Unsustainable fishing—including bycatch—poses a serious threat to vulnerable Mediterranean marine species such as sea turtles, dolphins, sharks, rays and seabirds. Despite recent efforts, significant knowledge gaps remain and proven solutions are not yet widely adopted, leaving both marine life and coastal livelihoods at risk.

#### **OUR MAIN PROJECT**


With this project, we strive to make bycatch reduction a lasting and integral part of sustainable fisheries management.



Roll out proven technical solutions to reduce impacts on turtles, dolphins and sharks, while safeguarding livelihoods.

#### **COLLECTING DATA**

Engage fishers in data collection, including through self-reporting apps and remote electronic monitoring.



#### FINANCING SOLUTIONS

Provide socio-economic incentives for small-scale fishers to adopt selective fishing and sustainable practices.

#### **ENSURING FUTURE ACTION**

Advocate for policy reform and bycatch action plans at national and regional (GFCM and EU) levels.
